EXEMPTION FOR IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE (IID)

I am exempt from the installation of an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) pursuant to §23573 of the California Vehicle Code (CVC) because I meet all of the following circumstances:

- I do not own a vehicle.
- I do not have access to a vehicle at my place of residence.
- I no longer have access to the vehicle used when I was arrested for the violation that resulted in a conviction under this section 23573 CVC.

I acknowledge that I am:

- Only allowed to drive a vehicle that is fitted with an operating IID.
- Required to have a valid driver license before I can drive.
- Subject to the requirements of this section when I purchase or have access to a vehicle.

If you are eligible and wish to file an exemption, complete and mail this form to the above address no later than 30 days from the above date.

The Department of Motor Vehicles must notify the court if you fail to submit a Department of Motor Vehicles Ordered Verification of Ignition Interlock (DL 924) or the DL 4054B form as required by law. A person who is required to install an IID and fails to do so is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months or by fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both.

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ORDER OF INSTALLMENT OF AN IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE (IID)

DRIVER LICENSE OR PLR NUMBER

The department received a notice of conviction for driving when suspended or revoked pursuant to §§14601.2, 14601.4, or 14601.5 of the California Vehicle Code (CVC). You must submit a Department of Motor Vehicles Ordered Verification of Ignition Interlock (Form DL 924) to the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) at the above address for each vehicle you own or operate for the term beginning on _____ through _____. You must also pay a \$40.00 IID administrative service fee to the DMV.

This action is due to the following conviction:

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The Department of Motor Vehicles must notify the court if you fail to submit proof of installation of an IID or an Exemption for Ignition Interlock Device(IID), DL 4054B form, within 30 days from the date of this notice. A person who is required to install an IID and fails to do so is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months or by fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both.

Contact a DMV certified IID installer by calling the toll-free number of one of the companies listed on the second page of this form. They will provide information regarding prices and availability of service in your area. The IID installer will provide you with a DL 924.

Once installed in your vehicle, the IID must be calibrated and inspected by a certified installer at intervals not to exceed 60 days. The inspections ensure the device is working properly with no evidence of tampering.

NOTE: The installation of an IID on a motor vehicle does not allow a person to drive without a valid driver license.

Persons may qualify for an exemption of the installation requirement of an IID provided they meet the exemption criteria listed on the attached DL 4054B notice.
